Ductform have been a member of the HVCA for 29 years, and the first Scottish Contractor to become accredited to BS:EN ISO 9001. Ductform manufactures, supplies, installs and certifies many ranges of ductwork systems including, Galvanised, Rectangular, Spiral, Stainless steel, Koolduct, Climaver, and fully inspected/certified 2hr & 4hr stability, integrity and insulated fire rated ductwork systems to BS476 part 24. In addition, they manufacture and deliver all of the above items and a full range of ancillary items for ductwork, such as Volume Control Dampers, Fire Dampers, and Access Doors on a supply only basis to our customers.

With ongoing concerns over global warming, and ever increasing environmental issues, the Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Industry is in the midst of a dynamic era of new technology and IT advancements. However, air distribution ductwork – a critical component of HVAC systems has remained virtually unchanged since the early 1900's. Several factors and recent innovation have introduced the need to revolutionise air distribution ductwork, and building materials and products have dramatically improved. Requirements for clean air are becoming increasingly stringent, and whilst energy use has continued to escalate, the speed of construction has become a valuable asset.

Ductform have developed a unique rectangular ducting system called 'tite-lite' which can reduce air leakage of up to 70% on all ranges of ductwork and is 30% lighter than conventional ductwork.

The visit shall consist of a tour of the fabrication workshop followed by a brief presentation and Q&A session. Safety glasses will be provided for the workshop tour, please ensure that sensible footwear is worn.

Due to likely high demand, a first come, first served approach to applications shall be observed. Numbers need to be confirmed as soon as possible, for staffing and catering purposes.

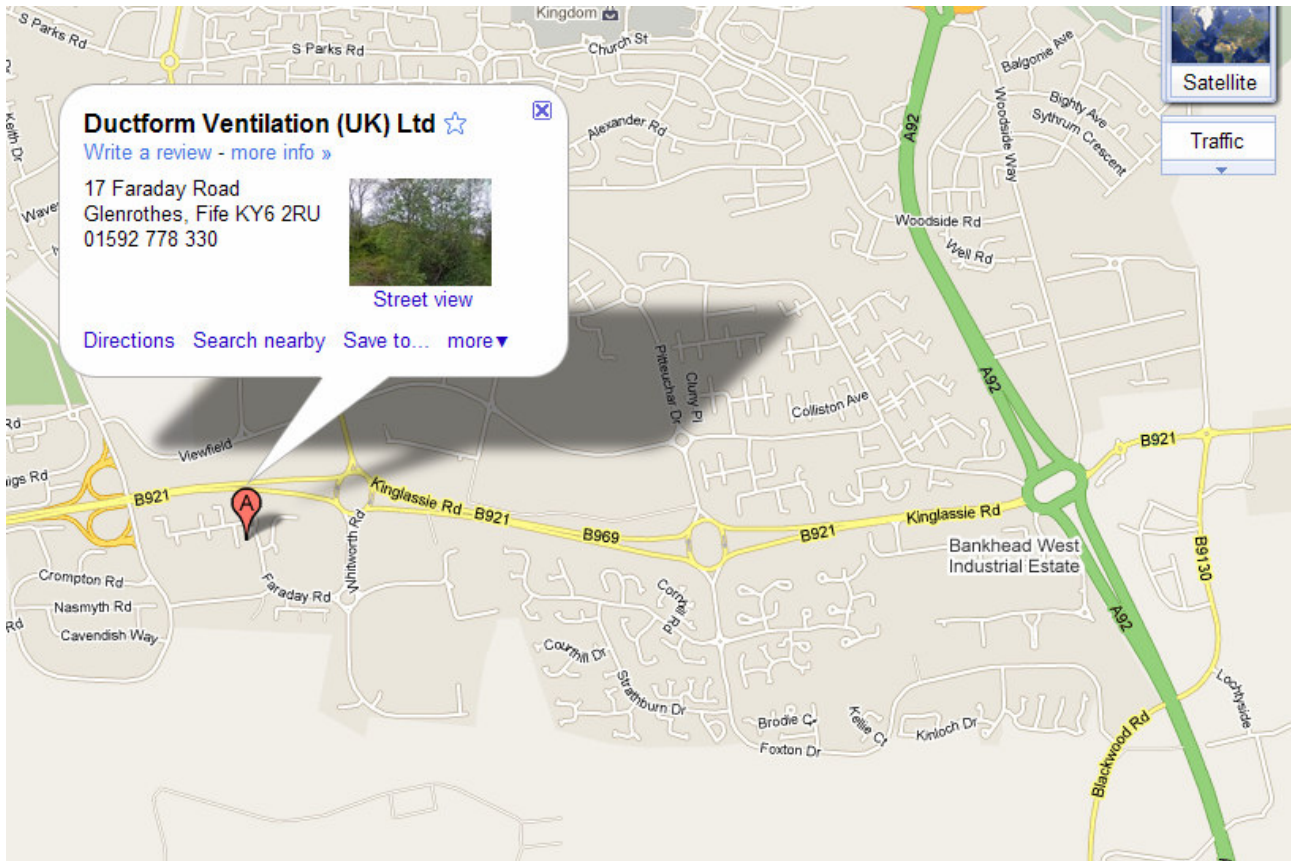
